Paper Submission Requirements

Thesis of Reports Structure

1) Initials and surnames of authors with indication of the scientific degree, full name of the organization in which the work is performed;

2) Title of thesis;

3) Main text;

4) Reference list (if any).

The volume of the thesis is from 1 to 2 pages of A5 format.

The document should be saved in **rtf** or **doc** format. The file should be named as a transliteration of the author's last name with the prefix T_* . For example, $T_{etrenko}(-Chubenko)$.

Thesis Formatting

Format: A5

Margin sizes: left – 24 mm; right, top, bottom – 18 mm.

Font: Times New Roman 10 pt; line spacing -1.0; paragraph indent -1 cm; alignment - justified. Avoid using extra spaces for alignment in the text.

Tables are numbered in the order of mention. The table number should be referenced in the text. The table number is indicated on a separate line aligned to the right (e.g., "Table 1."). Table titles are placed above the table aligned to the centre. The minimum font size in tables is 8 pt.

Scanning of images should be done with a resolution of at least 300 dpi. Images are saved in jpg or tif format. Line thickness (considering scaling) should not be less than 0.7 pt. Images are centered. Numbering of images is done according to their order of mention in the text. All labels on images should be clear and no smaller than 8 pt in size. Numbered captions are placed below the image with the label "Figure," followed by the figure number and caption text.

Formulas are created using MathType or Equation 3.0 editor. Formulas that are referenced in the text should have consecutive numbering throughout the document. Formula numbers are printed within parentheses near the right margin edge. The main font size for formula editor is 10 pt. Character sizes within formulas: normal -10 pt, large -16 pt, small -11 pt, large subscript -9 pt, small subscript -7 pt. Resizing formula objects is not allowed.

References to cited sources in-text follow this format example: [2, p. 362-367; 5, p 127; 7-9; 12], where first number represents reference number from list of cited sources, comma separated page numbers indicate specific pages (page range indicated by hyphen), multiple sources separated by semicolon or dash. If page numbers mentioned no need to include same while listing them under references section.
